MINUTES OF MEETING

A meeting of the resident ratepayers of the proposed ^{of Taylor} School District was held at M. J. Hoffmann on the 25th day of Dec 1905.
(Chairman of the Board of Education)
(Secretary of the Board of Education)

The meeting was called to order at one o'clock in the afternoon; Mr. Henry Gearing was duly appointed Chairman and Mr. W. B. Hull Secretary.

After the resident ratepayers had signed the declaration required by Section 18 of The School Ordinance, a poll was taken of the votes of the resident ratepayers for and against the formation of the proposed district.

The poll remained open for one hour and the result of the vote was as follows: For the erection of the district eighteen; against the erection of the district none.

- The following persons were then nominated for the office of Trustee in the order given:
- 1st Nomination, Mr. Henry Gearing Mover Mr. William Gearing Seconder Mr. H. Gearing
 - 2nd " Mr. Wm. Buntala Mover Mr. John Hoffmann Seconder Mr. Bernhard Gearing
 - 3rd " Mr. W. B. Hull Mover Mr. J. Hoffmann Seconder Mr. John Hoffmann
 - 4th " Mr. Frank Hoffmann Mover Mr. Bernhard Gearing Seconder Mr. W. Buntala
 - 5th " Mr. Bernhard Gearing Mover Mr. John Hoffmann Seconder Mr. Frank Hoffmann
 - 6th " Mr. John Gearing Mover Mr. W. Buntala Seconder Mr. W. Buntala

A poll was then opened for the election of Trustees and remained open for one hour. The result of the vote was as follows:

Mr. <u>Henry Gearing</u>	obtained	18	votes,
Mr. <u>William Buntala</u>	obtained	17	votes,
Mr. <u>W. B. Hull</u>	obtained	3	votes,
Mr. <u>Frank Hoffmann</u>	obtained	7	votes,
Mr. <u>Bernhard Gearing</u>	obtained	4	votes,
Mr. <u>John Gearing</u>	obtained	5	votes,
